GRPA Rules - New Rule Changes - ALL SPORTS:

- ▶ **The athletic manual is available online at www.grpa.org under the "Athletics" tab.** (All page # references are from the 2026 Athletic Manual).
- ▶ Motion that for team sports, all participants must have registered and be an integral part of the agency program no less than 45 days prior to the state tournament.
- ▶ 1st forfeit - \$500 fee and agency on probation for one year in the age group for the particular sport; 2nd forfeit (within 24-month period) - \$1000 fee and agency on suspension for one year from that sport.
- ▶ Motion to add state IDs to approved documents for youth participation.
- ▶ **Approved uniform: (1) plain shirts with numbers, (2) agency name or agency abbreviation, or (3) agency logo with department/school mascot name. (EFFECTIVE January 2025)**
 - ▶ *Recreation Agency Name" - NOT TEAM/CLUB/ETC

*Recreation Agency Name must be present on the Uniforms – Track Team/ Club Name only does not comply.

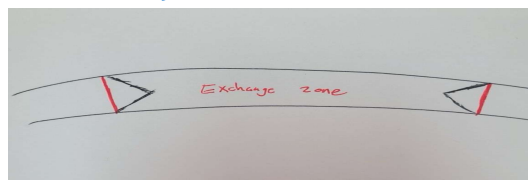
Uniform Rules Changed in 2025

- ▶ Page 33 and then review specific rules for any other rules regarding uniforms and penalties.
- ▶ **Any team who shows up to a GRPA district or state tournament wearing illegal uniforms or utilizing illegal equipment will be assessed a fine of \$200.** If a team has enough legal players to participate, they will be allowed to play, and the other members would have to sit out until their uniforms/equipment meets guidelines per various sport rules. If they do not have enough to play/participate, then they would have to forfeit (forfeit fees apply). **PLEASE CHECK SPECIFIC SPORT RULES** concerning violations of uniforms and how penalties will be assessed. **GRPA reserves the right to fine any agency not adhering to uniform guidelines in GRPA play.**

4x100M Relay



- ▶ The exchange must take place inside the red lines on the above diagram, which represent the ends of the large triangles (30M exchange zone).
- ▶ The runner waiting to receive the baton must be standing inside the 30M exchange zone (inside red lines on diagram) from the time the starting gun fires until they receive the baton.
- ▶ The passing of the baton commences when the baton is first touched by the outgoing runner and is completed when the baton is solely in the possession of the outgoing runner. If the baton is dropped in the exchange zone, either competitor may retrieve it, even from another lane, provided the competitor does not interfere with an opponent and the baton is retrieved within the limits of the original exchange zone extended across the track. If the baton is dropped outside the exchange zone, it must be retrieved by the competitor who dropped it.

Clarifications/ Interpretations

- ▶ Clear instructions should be given to event staff/teams about where and when practices can occur.
- ▶ The Main Warm-up period for all athletes in any event occurs before events begin while the "Track and Field are OPEN". There are areas outside of each competition site where athletes can practice their specific field event (exception - high jump) prior to competition. Once the track is closed, Track and Field Event warm-up is ceased.
- ▶ Individual field event participants will have one practice after all Athletes have been checked in for their age group. After that, they officially begin their competition for that specific age group.

*Clarification & Interpretation-

Alternates and Substitutions:

- ▶ Athletes in District RELAYS should be the same athletes in State RELAYS, however, if that athlete is not available their substitution can come from rostered athletes in the same sex and age group - **When all possible subs should be listed as alternates at time of entry.**
- ▶ In case there are no alternates then the athlete can come from the same sex/same age group of GRPA current rostered athlete.
 - Once the meet has begun alternates listed are the ones that can be utilized. If the alternate/s are not available, then a rostered athlete of the same sex in that age group can participate.
- ▶ If an athlete competes in an older age group relay, he/she can participate in their original lower age group for individual events.
- ▶ **Combined AGE group Relays are allowed for younger Athletes to compete in older relay and stay down for all Individual Field Events.**

Starting Pistol Clarifications - addition of a .209 and Use of .22

h. Track event equipment: starting pistol with .22, only at start end of 50M & 100M events(8u/10u) , .209 or .32 caliber black powder cartridges -(12u/14u 100M & all distance events), one or more whistles for the chief finish judge and starter or clerk of the course, stopwatches (minimum six to eighteen with extras in case of malfunction), legal batons for relays and any other necessary equipment. Optional equipment would include finish yarn, and judges' stand and lane indicators.

One .22 (start 8u/10u 50M, 100M), .209 or .32 caliber pistol shall be used for starts-(12u/14u 100M & all distance events).

- Hurdles (60m/80m/100m – age 9-14) will run as timed finals with 8 or less runners on Friday Evening – [1st event so track can be pre-set for 80M]
 - If more than 8 participants in an age group, then Pre-lims will be ran on Friday night with Finals on Saturday

800 Meter:

- As voted in 2024 will be a WATERFALL START



Shot Put: Clarification Only:

- Event is for 10U/12U and 14U (not 8U)

NOTE: Each competitor shall be allowed three trials in the finals of all field events, including high jump (three attempts per height).

Other rule changes for TRACK & FIELD – (see front of manual):

- Fully automatic electric timing is required for state-level competition and is highly recommended for District competition. If a District cannot secure electronic timing, the district is still required to submit complete results to a timer for entry into a Hytek file. **All District results must be submitted to the state host via a Hytek file.**
- Failure to **submit district results electronically to the state host** will result in a **\$250 fine, plus scratch fees at the regular price.** Failure to pay the district or state host within the allotted time mentioned above can result in fees being doubled by the host agency, as approved by the SAC Chair. If not received within the timeframe, Districts will be billed, and they are responsible for collecting from the agency.
- Each competitor **will be allowed three trials in the finals of all field events (including High Jump- M-JS, S-JF, V- 21-3 passed)**
- **Add 80M Hurdles to District and State competitions in the 10U, 12U, and 100M Hurdles for 14U age group** [see chart above for placement of hurdles]. 100M was clarified for the 14U at 33" during the SAC Meeting in Whitfield Co

- ▶ **Governing Rules - GRPA and GHSA** The National Federation (National Alliance Edition) Track and Field Rules is the official guide for GRPA meets, with exceptions as may be stated in this manual
- ▶ **Maximum Individual Athlete Entries - 3**
 - ▶ Two Running and One Field or Vice Versa
 - PLUS the 2 relays in that age division - pg 87 Art1 Sec B#3 ; Athlete May Also Run on Both Relays**
- ▶ **Team Must Wear Same Color Jersey**
 - ▶ Girls Identical and Boys Identical
- ▶ **BIB Number Must Be Worn at All Times**
 - ▶ Replacement Bib Number Fee - \$5.00
- ▶ **Timing - Finish Lynx - Fully Automatic**

GRPA Rules - con't

- ▶ Prescription Glasses and Sunglasses are Acceptable
 - ▶ Doctor's Prescription For Sunglasses Must Be Presented at the District and State Meets
- ▶ Wrist Watch is Acceptable
- ▶ Shoes Are MANDATORY
- ▶ Spikes are allowed
- ▶ No starter blocks
- ▶ Video or Pictures WILL NOT be used to determine any result of a race of field event!

- ▶ USA Track & Field and/or AAU Track Athletes
 - ▶ AAU/USATF membership card provides eligibility for participants to run with their year round club sponsored by a GRPA agency rather than the agency in their home county.
 - ▶ Athletes Must Be Current 2026 USATF and/or AAU Track Members With Their Club/Team - MUST BE ATTACHED.
 - ▶ Current 2026 Athlete Membership Card Must Be Submitted at the District and State Level

- ▶ **Field Events**
 - ▶ **Class A and B/C Measured in Feet and Inches**
 - ▶ Measurements will be in Feet and Inches unless otherwise specified for Long Jump, Running Long Jump, Softball Throw, Javelin, Shotput and Discus. High Jump - moved 2" at a time.
 - ▶ 3 Tries per Athlete
 - ▶ Exception - High Jump - **3 Tries per Height including High Jump - changed 2025**
 - ▶ Standing Long Jump - Will be contested in a sand pit
 - ▶ The host javelin and discus must be used at both the A and B/C state meet.
- ▶ **Running Events**
 - ▶ **Two False Starts = Disqualification**
 - ▶ 800 Meter Run - Waterfall Start- (adopted 2023)
 - ▶ 1600 and 3200 Meter Run - Waterfall Start
 - ▶ 60M / 80M /100M Hurdles - TF if less than 8 - if not Prelims (fri)/Finals (sat)
 - ▶ Prelims - **Top 8 Times Overall** Advance to the Finals
 - ▶ EVENTS With 8 or less Athletes Will be ran as a Time Final
 - ▶ No Prelims
 - All 800m, All 1600m, All 3200m, All Relays
 - 6-8 Girls and Boys 400m - Will Run as Time Final
- ▶ **Awards**
 - ▶ Medals - First Through Third Place - **to be presented on Awards Platform**
 - ▶ Ribbons - Fourth Through Eighth Place- **to be presented on Awards Platform**
