# **GRPA Committee Leadership:**

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Georgia Recreation and Park Association is proud to recognize and honor extraordinary people, programs, and agencies who serve throughout the great state of Georgia. Nominations for award are solicited annually and scored by a panel of judges representing each of GRPA's districts and networks.

### **2025 Awards Timeline:**

- **Nomination Submission Timeline:** August 1st through September 1, 2025. Awards are submitted via the GPRA website: <a href="www.grpa.org">www.grpa.org</a>.
- Nomination deadline: September 1, 2025, at 5 p.m. Please check for email notification that the award nomination was received.
- Awards judging: The committee shall judge all awards during the period of September 8th 19th, 2024.
- Awards Winners Due to Card: September 26, 2024.
- **Notification of Winners:** The Awards Chair shall notify awards recipients no later than October 3, 2025.
- Award Winner Photos Due and Table RSVP's: October 10th.
- **Annual Conference:** November 3-6th Jekyll Island.

## **Requirements and Recommendations:**

- Prior to the awards' submittal, the person making the nomination is to make sure the Supervisor / Department Director is aware before it is submitted. Additionally, if the nominee is a department Director, their City/County Manager must be aware of the nomination before it is submitted.
- When submitting awards, first determine the appropriate network, award category, and population
  category prior to starting the submission. The Awards Committee recommends writing your
  nomination first within a Word document so that you can carefully review and proof it and confirm
  the word count prior to copying it into your online submission. Each award features eligibility
  criteria. The Awards Committee reserves the right to determine if nominations meet eligibility
  requirements.



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## **Network and Marketing Award Requirements and Reminders:**

- Agencies may submit a limit of one (1) nomination per category.
- Awards nominations must comprise of achievements made during the period of **August 1, 2024- July 31, 2025.**
- The nominee must not have previously received the award for the nomination.
- Nominees must be a GRPA member in good standing and network specific to award (Volunteers and the Distinguished Administrative Support Staff Awards are exceptions).
- Photos submitted must be at least 2 MB; High pixel (1920x1080); landscape preferred; no collage photos.
- It is recommended that nominees be prepared with 8-10 high quality photos on file in the event they are requested for presentation.

## **Non-Network Award Requirements and Reminders:**

- Nominee has not received the award previously.
- The Agency of the Year winners are ineligible to win two consecutive years. Nominee/Agency must be a GRPA member in good standing.
- Photos submitted must be at least 2 MB; High pixel (1920x1080); landscape preferred; no collage photos.

### **Tips for Applications:**

- Review the award criteria first! This will ensure you select the appropriate nomination to be submitted.
- Plan ahead! Have a timeline and plan to submit ahead of the award deadline.
- Stay on topic and organize your thoughts.
- Share the passion and the "why" you are nominating the nominee.
- Do not overthink the award submittal.
- Be clear and answer every question.
- Make sure you follow the word limit or character limit. Do not write a novel.
- Review. Review. And review again prior to submittal online.
